OUR ADVOCACY


- Mobilising resources to increase hepatitis testing, treatment and cure
 - Collaboration to better integrate hepatitis patient-focused care and UHC
 - Maximising impact of Global Fund changes through member support
 - Challenging other funders to broaden scope to include hepatitis
- Advocating for PMTCT and triple elimination/birth dose
 - Building allies within other communities to amplify influence
 - Focus on Gavi to pressure to implement VIS strategy
- Hepatitis testing, treatment and cure as liver cancer prevention
 - Partnership and collaboration with cancer organisations
 - Engaging with funders and policy-makers to advocate for NCD funds






OUR CAMPAIGNS

- Our Hep Can't Wait campaign continues:
 - social media, webinars, policy influencing work
 - a platform for voices to be globally heard and awareness raised
 - vehicle to deliver content and collaboration
- World Hepatitis Day (WHD) (28 July):
 - one of only 11 official WHO recognised health awareness days
 - run by WHA and used by the community for raising awareness, tackle misinformation and stigma
 - in 2022 #WorldHepatitisDay reached over 300m people, received over 745 press articles (1.5bn readers) and saw 70 organisations join a global virtual 'relay' across 26 countries










